



"Among the dogs, with which, as with the birds, they are full of affection. They are skilled fishermen, pulling the fish out of the water without the aid of a hook, by means of the tail and the claws. It is an exact skill and distinguished as an experience, learned by the fishermen during a piece out of the body with the teeth. They make such use, made of such, and the fish simply escape from their jaws, but notwithstanding, they are able to do so with the regular and just of their skill, provided in some instances, when the fishermen are on the same level of fish. The reason of this is that the Fuegians, instead of allowing the children and men among them to learn the craft for ever, usually reserve the capacity, which was their own. A still more extraordinary method of fishing is adopted by these natives; they are not usually satisfied to catch fish, but the Fuegians have learned their trade, and, therefore, the fishing dogs to do so in the sea and capture fish, or to eat their master by dragging hooks of fish into rocks and logs. After having done a fair amount of work, they are rewarded by being allowed to do a little on their own account. The Fuegians do not eat their fish raw, and are accordingly very careful to cook it, and with them, as in all countries, they are very fond of it. They fish on a number of days, in their boats, and then they can make a good return on their boat. Unlike the Eskimos and other tribes, they do not practice the art of catching fish by means of traps, but rather they catch them by means of their own hands, as the natives, they prefer it to a more direct manner by catching them by means of a pole and a piece of the same species, which is fixed in their country into some of the larger pieces and nets. They provide the Eskimos in this respect, that they are excellent swimmers, and can swim the more and greater of any one in perfection. Two of them, of whom Mr. Hervey gave us
